# Study tour to Setubal, Portugal "Art and Culture"

A short term programme, with focus on Art and Culture in 2016, from 28.02 - 05.03.

There will be students and lecturers from four different Higher Education Institutions in Europe. From University College UCC, Denmark; from Polytechnic Institute of Setúbal, Portugal; from Thomas More Hogeschool, Holland and from Howest University College, Belgium. All students will be studying either Teachers education or Social education.

Around 28 students from Denmark, Belgium, Holland and Portugal will be together at a short-term course in beginning of March-2016. Seven students from each Institution will get the option to be part of this course.

### Content of the course

### Aims: Students completing this course will achieve:

- Awareness of aesthetic and creative processes in Arts Education
- Craftsmanship and skills in creative and aesthetic expressions
- Knowledge of different pedagogical methods
- Knowledge of Portuguese Arts, typical Portuguese music, visual art, dance, drama
- The capacity to reflect about own experiences with creative expressions
- Understanding of the creative process involving theory
- Working with comparative perspectives on art and didactics

On the course, we will work with the aesthetic cultural practice through the medium of the arts in order to gain knowledge about the artistic culture of Portugal as well as awareness and self-knowledge in the process. Through the arts, we will create different culture meetings to make sense of our lives.

Through the arts, we can go across borders and cultures creating cultural - and personal symbols that allow us to transform experience into knowing.
